- Operating Procedures can be found at <http://www.roadtrekchapter.org>
- In general you can post anything related to Roadtreks and Roadtrekking
- Includes, but not limited to, driving, parking, navigation, cooking, camping, communications; storage, entertainment modes, travel routings, destinations, places to stay, modifications, accessories, problems, etc.
- Share lifestyles, including activities that enhance motorhome use.

HOW DO I JOIN?

- Your FMCA and Roadtrek International dues must be current

- A moderator will subscribe you and you will be sent instructions and a unique access password

MODERATORS

- Enroll members, post general messages and manage database
- Monitor message content to ensure topics stay on track and help members
- Provide CyberRally technical support
- Privately interface with and moderate any member not adhering to the CyberRally Operating Procedure.
- **NOTE:** The moderators DO NOT read any CyberRally email before it is posted unless a member has been put on Moderation. This typically happens when a member's email has been hacked and is posting Spam

HOW DO I RECEIVE EMAIL?

- Messages will be delivered in either REGULAR or DIGEST format
- You decide upon the format desired
 - REGULAR : Standard email when it's posted it will be sent to you
 - DIGEST : Messages are combined into one email such that, at most, you will receive only one email per day.

HOW DO I POST & REPLY TO MESSAGES?

- You send a standard email to **cyberrally@roadtrekchapter.org**
- You respond to messages by doing a REPLY and providing your response
 - Response should always include the CyberRally unless it is of personal nature
 - Delete any message content not directly related to the question and answer.
- Responding to a DIGEST message requires more effort to eliminate non related content

Digest Responses

- Special attention must be given to any responses to Digest Email
- Several messages will be included in each digest
- You must change the subject line to reflect what you are responding to
- You must delete all non relevant responses

CYBERRALLY OPTIONS

- Members can control START/STOP & REGULAR/DIGEST modes themselves
- Instructions are sent to members when registering
- Moderators can perform task for members when requested. This is the members easiest method.

CYBERRALLY ETIQUETTE

- Non-Roadtrek-related products and/or services shall not be advertised
- Roadtrek-related products or services may be advertised
- Political views, causes, or campaigns may not be posted.
- Postings should include
 - A subject that reflects the (main) content.
 - Your name, city, state/province, make, model and year of your Roadtrek.
- Be polite to your fellow Roadtrek International members

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- All CyberRally email is processed into ASCII format to prevent any virus transmission
- Postings can contain hyperlinks and some HTML but graphics or attachments will be stripped off
- All Key CyberRally information is available on Roadtrek International website.
