"Rocky Mountain High 2025" Roadtrek Chapter Meeting and Rally Sunday July 20th till Thursday July24th

(With options to reserve another night or so)

For the first time in over seventeen years we are having a rally in Colorado. We are camping next to the Big Thompson River just outside the city of Loveland, Colorado. (Elevation 4997ft. above sea level) Besides having a relaxing, forested, campsite near the river to breath in the mountain air; you also have plenty of activities to explore. There are about 36 breweries in the immediate area, Colorado State University, a Free 10 acre Sculpture Park with 178 pieces. 20 minutes away in Fort Collins, you can see large sculptures, painted pianos, 400 creatively painted city transformer cabinets, and Old Town Main Street that inspired the design for Disneyland Main Street. Also, there is a Totally 80's Museum and Pizza place and a 1919 style restored Trolley to ride. If you like biking there is an amazing network of bike trails. Feeling like making this a longer vacation? Extend your camping for Thursday and Friday. You can make your camping reservations for additional nights and drive 50 minutes up to 7522 ft. above sea level to the town of Estes Park and the entrance to Rocky Mountain National Park. You can drive another 45 minutes to the highest visitor center in our National Park system, (11,796 ft. above sea level.) (Rocky Mountain National Park requires reservation times to enter the park. Website is: recreation.gov

NEXT SECURE YOUR ROADTREK RALLY CAMPING SPACE:

Get your reservations as soon as possible. July is prime camping season in Colorado; the campgrounds fill up fast. You must CALL the campground immediately and secure your spot. (It is winter now so leave a message that you are a Roadtrek wanting to get one of our sites for Sun. July 20th thru Wed. July 23rd and leave your phone # and good time to call.) They will call you back as they check their messages even though the campground is on winter hours. If you go on line and look at the campground you will see that many sites are taken. Some campsites are posted as taken because I have them tentatively reserved for YOU. I will have to relinquish them to the public in May.

(You might want to plan a couple more nights if you plan to go to Rocky Mountain National Park just up the mountain from the campground.) The Park requires reserving a window of time to enter the park. (see <u>recreation.gov.</u> Or make reservations using the <u>recreation.gov</u> mobile app,)

After getting you campground reservations please fill in the following form for the Chapter Meeting and Rally and send the **rally registration form** and your **rally fee** to me so I can finalize tours and caterers. (The sooner the better)

Important Message from the Chapter Secretary

At the end of December 2024, the Roadtrek Chapter membership for many of you expired. The recent email you received had your expiration date at the top of the email. If it said 12/24, that was the last email you will receive unless you renew. If you renewed and the date is not correct, let the secretary know at sec@roadtrekchapter.org.

When renewing **please** use the online form. https://www.roadtrekchapter.org/ and click the Red button on the right that says "Join or Renew".

Complete the form, indicate that this is a renewal and how many years you wish to pay. If there is a problem, a message will be displayed providing an explanation.

We use PayPal to process credit card payments as this is the most cost-effective option available to us. **You do not need to create a PayPal account**. We have had thousands of successful payments received.

When you click the link, and the form is filled out correctly, it will take you to the PayPal site. You may pay as a guest with your credit card. **However**, if you have a PayPal account, then you will need to log on with your PayPal user ID and password.

Caution, you may have inadvertently created an account in the past. If this happened, then you will need to "recover" your password. You **cannot** pay as a guest if an account exists with the email address you are using.

In very **rare cases** some people have trouble getting PayPal to work. PayPal uses sophisticated algorithms to detect fraud. Sometimes the system gets a false positive for fraud. The system won't say why, it just won't work. In the end it may be easier to just send a check.

If you must pay by check, complete the form, click the pay by check button and send the secretary a check made out to Roadtrek International. Please include your FMCA number on the check.

Thanks for your help and cooperation.

FMCA dues are due on the anniversary of the date you joined FMCA. You must be current with your FMCA dues to remain a member of Roadtrek International. FMCA sends me a report every month on who has not paid.

The excursions include a guided tour of the Arkansas Inland Marine Museum, guided tour of the Old Mill (a historic re-creation of an 1880's water-powered grist mill used in the opening scenes of the classic movie "Gone With The Wind."), riding the trolley and stopping along the way at the Arkansas Historic Museum and have lunch (on your own). There will be free time to chose visiting the Clinton Presidential Center (that is just across a pedestrian bridge), the Old State House, Arkansas Museum of Fine Arts, other places, or just relax.

Every afternoon we will have a social hour, followed by a meal, then a tech talk or playing games with prizes.
