Since this is our 1<sup>st</sup> Newsletter for 2025, there have been recent changes that you might have missed in past Newsletters that might be important to you.

- 1. The FMCA Assist benefit has new phone numbers. Past year phone numbers should be updated on cell phone contacts and medical information you carry in your Roadtrek, etc. FMCA Assist numbers are: Canada/US toll free (844)289-3442 and International (443)901-4691
- 2. A new benefit called GROUPER may help you pay your FMCA dues. (See more on FMCA website under Members Benefits.)
- 3. FMCA dues increased to \$99. Per year.
- 4. Roadtrek International Chapter By-Laws changed, and we now have a category of membership called "Alumni". It allows members who have sold their Roadtrek and do not own another RV, to remain members with all benefits. (but are not allowed to hold office)

Region 9 hosted a chapter rally in Tucson 2022 and here we go again. No one can remember the last time we had a rally in the State of Colorado but now we are having our Chapter Rally in the Presidents home state.

#### Details at the moment:

"Riverview" campground is nestled next to the Big Thompson River, 10 minutes from Loveland, Colorado. It is about a mile above sea level. We will be located in a circle section near the river and next to the recreational hall. When you call the office for reservation please identify yourself as a Roadtrek International Member for the rally July  $20^{th}$  to  $24^{th}$ . At this time you could opt to spend a little more \$ and be on the river near our circle however you can see the river on the bridge as you cross it entering the camp. There is also a walking trail.

If you want to get an entry time reserved to go into Rocky Mountain National Park and drive even higher, (like 11,000 feet above sea level) You might want to reserve Thur. night also. High Altitudes may not be an option for those with heart or breathing issues.

Get your reservation and start planning the rest of your vacation. There are plenty of places to visit in Southern Colorado following I-25 and about 1 hour North on I-25 is Frontier Days in Cheyenne, Wyoming.

# **Important Message from the Chapter Secretary**

At the end of December 2024, the Roadtrek Chapter membership for many of you will expire. The recent email you received had your expiration date at the top of the email.

When renewing **please** use the online form. <a href="https://www.roadtrekchapter.org/">https://www.roadtrekchapter.org/</a> and click the Red button on the right that says "Join or Renew".

Complete the form, indicate that this is a renewal and how many years you wish to pay. If there is a problem, a message will be displayed providing an explanation.

We use PayPal to process credit card payments as this is the most cost-effective option available to us. You do not need to create a PayPal account. We have had thousands of successful payments received.

When you click the link, and the form is filled out correctly, it will take you to the PayPal site. You may pay as a guest with your credit card. **However,** if you have a PayPal account, then you will need to log on with your PayPal user ID and password.

**Caution**, you may have inadvertently created an account in the past. If this happened, then you will need to "recover" your password. You **cannot** pay as a guest if an account exists with the email address you are using.

In very **rare cases** some people have trouble getting PayPal to work. PayPal uses sophisticated algorithms to detect fraud. Sometimes the system gets a false positive for fraud. The system won't say why, it just won't work. In the end it may be easier to just send a check.

If you must pay by check, complete the form, click the pay by check button and send the secretary a check. Please include your FMCA number on the check.

Thanks for your help and cooperation.

FMCA dues are due on the anniversary of the date you joined FMCA. You must be current with your FMCA dues to remain a member of Roadtrek International. FMCA sends me a report every month on who has not paid.


